Hvitträsk is an outstanding example of Jugendstil, the German and Scandinavian variant of Art Nouveau. It was built of logs and natural stone in 1903 to serve as the studio of the architects Saarinen, Gesellius and Lindgren and the home of Eliel Saarinen. It stands in a forest setting on a hill overlooking a beautiful lake.
